The Clark County Forestry and Parks Department has an immediate need for 1-2 LTE Forester positions. This is a limited-term (up to 1300 hours) position. Primary responsibilities and duties include forest regeneration metric surveys, timber sale establishment, and forest inventory. Other duties may include oak timber stand improvements projects, invasive species identification and control, assisting with timber sale administration, and other miscellaneous forest management tasks. This position offers valuable training and experience for those in pursuit of a full-time professional forestry career.

Preferred qualified candidates will have graduated or are enrolled in an accredited curriculum with course work toward a degree in Forestry, a related field, or an equal combination of education and experience sufficient to successfully perform the essential duties and responsibilities of the job
